NOMINATION CRITERIA

- 1) Organizations may submit no more than two nominations in each category.
- 2) No individual may be nominated in more than one category.
- 3) Individuals may be nominated in the same category in subsequent years.

CATEGORY GUIDELINES

SERVICE TO CHILDREN AND/OR PATIENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS...

Service to patients 18 or younger **or** patients who are physically or mentally challenged, chronically ill or otherwise require special care. Consideration given to for donated or low cost treatment.

SERVICE TO THE UNDERSERVED... Service to patients who suffer financial hardship and require special care. Consideration given for free or low cost treatment to populations including the homeless, elderly, working poor, etc...

SERVICE TO THE WORLD COMMUNITY... All service to patients outside of the United States.

SERVICE TO THE DENTAL PROFESSION... All service to the dental profession. Consideration will be given to any individual within our community who has demonstrated outstanding advocacy/service on behalf of dentistry in the past year.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Award recipients will be honored at the MDDS Annual Meeting and Society Dinner in a special ceremony. The award includes a commemorative statuette, prominent acknowledgement in the August 2008 issue of the MDDS *Articulator Magazine*, and a local media campaign on behalf of the recipients, their organization and the lives they have touched.
